SELECTION AND TUITION

Applications: Anyone engaged in a career or other endeavor and having an interest in local business and community affairs is invited to apply.

Selection: Candidates will be selected with a view toward establishing a diverse mix of ages, professions, activities and outlooks as evidenced on the applications.

Tuition: \$350 Edgewood Chamber Members
\$445 *Non-Members

*(includes Chamber Membership for 1 year)

Your tuition fee is payable upon notification of selection or by January 5. This fee covers the costs of class materials and organization, graduation banquet, Jackets, Notebooks and pins.

Deposit: A deposit of \$50 must accompany this application. If you are selected it will be applied to your tuition. If not it will be refunded immediately.

Tuition must be paid in full by January 5, and is non refundable after January 19, 2012

Scholarships: two partial scholarships are available. Typically these are awarded to nonprofit organizations or individuals not affiliated with a business.

Attendance: Leadership Edgewood consists of six sessions and the graduation banquet in July. Participants may not be absent more than 1 day total. It is vital for both the individual and the class that each member be present to add his or her perspective.

Method: A maximum of 20 East Mountain class members will begin their experience with a morning "retreat" and immersion in the topics on Jan 19. A total of 6 "day" sessions, one each month, January through June on the third Thursday of each month are the class requirements. The banquet and graduation celebration in July will culminate the learning experience.
